

**Department of Bioenvironmental Systems Engineering Guidelines for
Master program students**

Amended by the 1st Departmental Affairs meeting on the 1st semester of 2010 academic year on Oct. 14, 2010

(If there is any inconsistency or ambiguity between the English version and the Chinese version, the Chinese version shall prevail.)

Article 1 The period of Mater program is from two years to four years, and students shall complete a minimum of 24 credit hours excluding six credit hours of thesis during the period. Master's degree is conferred on the students who have passed the oral defense of Master Degree examination.

Article 2 Restrictions for the advisor of the graduate students are as follows:

- I. Every teacher can advise at most five students within two years but beneath three students in one year. Teachers meeting any condition of the following can advise one more student :
 1. Having been evaluated as an excellent-teaching teacher of school.
 2. Having obtained an award of excellent research from National Science Council.
 3. A distinguished professor.
 4. Other outstanding presentations approved by Academic and Teaching Committee.
- II. Departmental office will notice the students who haven't selected his/her advisor to have an interview with professors. If students cannot select the advisors yet, department chairman will advise them temporarily until the advisor is selected by the end of the first semester.

Article 3 Master program students who want to exempt credits shall follow the rules in accordance with "National Taiwan University Guidelines for Student's Course Exemption".

Article 4 Master program students who want to apply for direct admission into Ph.D. program shall follow the rules in accordance with "National Taiwan University Guidelines for Direct Admission into Ph.D. Program".
